Who we are



We are **All In**. We want everyone to feel welcome when they visit **creative and cultural venues**.



Creative and cultural venues are places like theatres, concert halls, museums, festivals and cinemas. In this booklet we call these venues.



We are a **disabled-led** team, so we know how hard it can be for disabled people to visit venues.



Disabled-led means that more than half of our managers are disabled.

What we want to do



We want to make it easier for D/deaf, disabled, and **neurodivergent** people to visit venues.



Neurodivergent means your brain works in a different way from other people and this affects your day to day life.



There are lots of reasons it might be hard for you to visit venues. We call these reasons **barriers**.



Barriers are things like if the venue is hard for you to move about in or if you have to tell lots of different people about your needs.



It should not be hard or upsetting to do the things you love. We know it can be difficult to book tickets for the cinema, go to the theatre or see a **live stream**.



A live stream is when you watch a concert or a play at home over the internet.



We want you to have a great time when you visit venues. From when you decide to go to when you get home.



We will talk to and work with disabled people to find out how to make it easier for them to visit venues.



We will take our time to think about and test ways for disabled people to visit venues more easily.

What we will do



We will make a set of rules for venues to follow that makes it easier for you to visit.



These rules will make it easier for you to tell venues what you need from them.



This means you will not have to tell staff at venues about your disability every time you visit.



We will make sure staff at venues are trained to follow these rules.
