Who we are



We are **All In**. We want everyone to feel welcome when they visit **creative and cultural venues**.



Creative and cultural venues are places like theatres, concert halls, museums, festivals and cinemas. In this booklet we call these venues.



We are a **disabled-led** team, so we know how hard it can be for disabled people to visit venues.



Disabled-led means that more than half of our managers are disabled.

What we want to do



We want to make it easier for D/deaf, disabled, and **neurodivergent** people to visit venues.



Neurodivergent means your brain works in a different way from other people and this affects your day to day life.



There are lots of reasons it might be hard for you to visit venues. We call these reasons **barriers**.



Barriers are things like if the venue is hard for you to move about in or if you have to tell lots of different people about your needs.



We will work with venues to make it easier for disabled people to visit them.



We will talk to different types of venues to make sure our plans to make them easier to visit work for everyone.



We know that lots of venues already have good ways they help disabled people. We want to help you make these even better.



We want to know how you help disabled people visit you and what you think could make it even easier for them.



We do not want our plans to make things harder for you if you already have ways to help disabled people visit you.

What we will do



We will make a set of rules for you to follow that makes it easier for disabled people to visit.



We will make sure staff at your venue are trained to follow these rules.



We will make a website where disabled people who want to visit venues can create a **profile**.



A **profile** shows information about the disabled person and what they need to make it easy to visit venues.



We will help you talk to **suppliers** who can help make your venue easier for disabled people to visit.



Suppliers are businesses that can help you be more accessible by selling you things or changing your building.



You can find a list of suppliers and other people who can help on our website.
