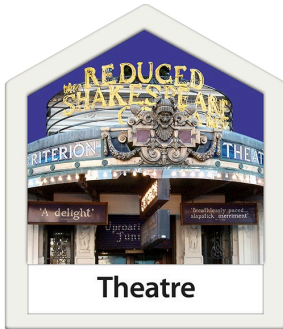

Who we are and what this booklet is about



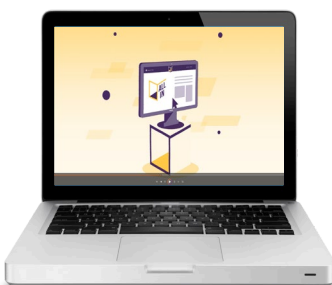
We are **All In**. We want everyone to feel welcome when they visit **creative and cultural venues**.

Sometimes there are **barriers** which can stop disabled people taking part.



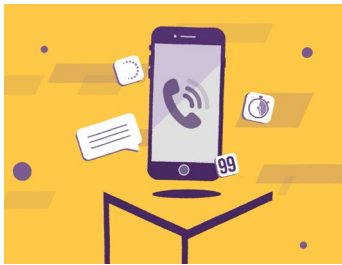
Barriers can be things like steps or confusing signs or loud noises.



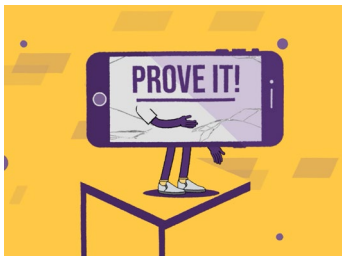
Or if you need BSL, Easy Read or subtitles and don't get them.



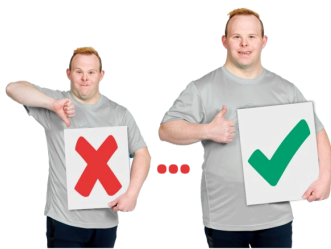
Sometimes barriers are not obvious.

Or if someone asks you to prove you are disabled lots of times.



We know things can be better.



We are **All In** and we know that everyone should be able to take part in culture and be creative.



We are made up of disabled people and we want to help other disabled people.



If you work at a creative and cultural venue we want to make it easy for disabled people to tell you what they need.



- We can train you to meet everyone's needs.



- We can help you meet the UK **accessibility standards**. **Accessibility standards** are rules to help venues be accessible to everyone.



- We can offer 1 to 1 help and advice which means we can help your venue with what's most important to you.



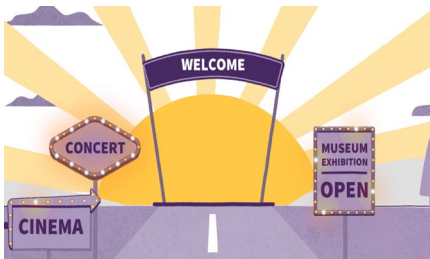
- We have a list of people who can help your venue.
